Blue Box Recycling

Items must be empty, clean and loose. Do not bag.





Aluminum cans, tins, foil



Glass jars, bottles





Cardboard (Flattened and bundled 2'x2'x1')

Yard Material

- Collected April to December
- · Same day as clear bag garbage
- · Branches/twigs must be bundled

No grass clippings, soil or sod



Clear Bag Garbage

CLEAR BAGS ONLY.

NO dark, white, or blue bags.

Wooden/bamboo cutlery, stir sticks



Disposable furnace filters

- Max. 3 items



Pour or wipe it into your kitchen catcher.





Alkaline Batteries Only


- · A, AA, AAA, C, D, 9V, button
